WHAT WE'VE HEARD We have been engaging Community Members since 2021 to inform the Chiyaxw Child and Family Law and service model. This page provides a summary of the Squamish culture and teachings we've heard about so far.



CEREMONIES

- Ceremonies mark individual, family, and community milestones
- Practicing ceremonies can teach and honour families
- We need to include ceremonies in services and staff training



 History is passed down from Elders orally. This includes our history of the land, identity, families, and colonialism

LANGUAGE



- Our language is grounding
- We need to change language that stigmatizes, triggers, and traumatizes families
- We need to use Squamish terms and supportive language
- Law and policies need to be understandable by all family members

TRADITIONAL LAWS & TEACHINGS

- Our Traditional Laws are taught by speaking and practiced by doing
- We have teachings about multigenerational living, family roles, raising children, and practicing customs within families
- We need to make Squamish teachings, values, and spirituality the foundation of Chiyáxw, including: families helping families, teaching children our culture, and focusing on healing
