Re: Update on Squamish Nation Distribution Program

The Squamish Nation Council is pleased to announce approval for a special payment, again this year, ahead of the holidays.

Council recognizes the ongoing financial hardships of our people, often more difficult during the holidays. We hear your concerns regarding distribution amounts and recognize this is a priority issue in our community.

The distribution for December 2024 will be a total of \$1,539. This amount includes:

- The Regular Distribution;
- One-Time Distribution;
- And Cost of Living Adjustment.

Regular Distribution

People will receive the normal December Distribution of \$500.

One-Time 2024 Distribution

People will receive \$1,000 in a special payment during this year's December Distribution.

Cost of Living Adjustment

A Cost-of-Living Adjustment (COLA) is an increase to help people keep up with rising prices for everyday things such as food, housing, and transportation. It's designed to make sure your money can still buy the same amount, even when the cost of living goes up because of inflation.

In the coming years, all annual distribution payments will increase by a cost-of-living adjustment tied to the Canadian Consumer Price Index (CPI). For 2024/2025, the CPI's cost of living adjustment is 3.9 per cent, which comes to a total increase of \$39.

- Clients that receive direct deposit will receive their benefits on December 30, 2024
- All clients and landlords that receive cheques, they will be delivered on December 30, 2024. <u>Please ensure you're home</u> to receive and accept your cheque.
- Squamish Nation offices are closed for Christmas Holidays from Dec 20, 2024 to Jan 1, 2025.
- IF YOU ARE NOT HOME to receive your Income Assistance benefits or rent you will be able to pick up your cheque at the office January 2, 2025 when Nation offices open.

NEW Woodwork Training Program

The Woodwork Training Program running from October 28 - December 19, has given students the opportunity to gain a unique set of skills and work on a legacy project.

The students are learning how to safely and correctly use the following machines:

- Table saw used for cutting across and with the wood grain
- Band saw used to cut both wood and metal stock
- Jointer used for flattening on face of a board/wood
- Planer used to mill a board to a uniform thickness from rough-cut lumber
- Plus many more!

After learning how to use the above tools, students put their knowledge to the test by making their own charcuterie boards.

In the final weeks of the program, students will embark on their legacy project: crafting the trays on which the medals will be presented for the 2025 Invictus Games.




Carpentry Level 1 Graduation






